

JAMES FALLON HIGH SCHOOL YEAR 11 CROSSROADS

To meet the requirements of the Preliminary course, all Year 11 students must undertake the MANDATORY Crossroads program to be eligible to continue on to the HSC course.

The Crossroads program is a 25 hour course designed to assist students in facing a variety of issues such as alcohol/drug use, resilience, motivation, relationships and stress management. This course will be delivered by James Fallon High School through a compulsory Year 11 camp to be held at Lake Hume Resort on the Tuesday, Wednesday & Thursday of the last week of Term 3. It will involve a number of seminars provided by outside agencies such as the NSW Police and Health professionals, and other activities.

Students will need to attend the camp to meet the requirements and be able to proceed to the HSC course. Please be advised that student work commitments will not be accepted as a reason not to attend the camp.

The approximate cost of the camp is \$150.00. (The amount does not include food, as students will be responsible for supplying and preparing their own meals). The camp cost will be invoiced with your school fees, but be aware this cost is subject to change depending on the nature of our guest speakers. We will give you notice as soon as possible of any changes.
